One-Year Full-Time Position

Pomona College's Economics Department seeks a one-year full-time visitor with demonstrated excellence in teaching and a commitment to educating diverse motivated students. The teaching load is one section of Principles of Macroeconomics and two sections of Principles of Microeconomics in the fall, and two sections of Principles of Microeconomics in the spring. Class size is capped at 30. There is a possibility of renewal based on performance and department needs. Visitors are eligible for internal travel and research grants. Subsidized housing in Claremont is likely available.

Pomona College is a highly selective liberal arts college with a diverse national and international student body. It is the founding member of the Claremont Colleges, a consortium that includes five contiguous colleges and two graduate schools. The consortium has over 40 economists and there are frequent economics seminars.

Applicants should submit the following: (1) a cover letter, (2) a CV, (3) a statement on teaching, (4) a statement on mentoring diverse students, (5) teaching evaluations, and (6) three letters of reference. Review of applications begins immediately and lasts until an appointment is made.
