Tenure-track candidates (Assistant Professor) must demonstrate the ability for high-quality instruction and the potential for significant research. Applicants must have PhD degree, or foreign equivalent, in a relevant field by the start of the appointment and will be expected to participate in undergraduate and graduate teaching and independent research.

Tenured candidates (Associate or Full Professor) must be engaged in important ongoing research, have a superior publication record, and have demonstrated effectiveness in both undergraduate and graduate teaching.
