


The development of GDP and GDP per workingage population




Long-run projection of Japan's GDP growth





The improvement of mortality rate in Japan





Different concept of old-age dependency ratio





A decline in total factor productivity in Japan



Steady rise in median age in Japan




Changes in population of municipality


Working-age population growth and inflation: Cross country comparison
